Content

Towards the end of a masters degree is a good time for interested students to advance into the world of scientific talks. The first step will be to prepare in advance, by taking turns having short student talks about the concepts in the announcement. Afterwards, we will meet for a final discussion on the talk. The purpose of the final meeting is not just to discuss the content, but also to analyze the style of the talk, for example in order to find out what might have made it hard to follow.
